## HOMESCHOOL ONSITE EXPECTATIONS & AGREEMENT

Thank you for your interest in Trinity River Audubon Center. Prior to your homeschool visit, please review the following guidelines. A signature is required for each participant and indicates your agreement to the guidelines.

- We would like to ensure that your visit is a great one! Due to the increased number of requests, we ask that you email <a href="mailto:trac@audubon.org">trac@audubon.org</a> with the preferred date and time of your homeschool visit. We will try to accommodate your preference, but please note that other programming may necessitate a different date. Please wait for confirmation from our team before visiting.
- One Leader/Contact must be designated for each homeschool group to facilitate scheduling your visit at the center.
- Each student must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian who is 18 years or older.
- Trinity River Audubon Center includes outdoor activities including hiking. Please dress appropriately and for the weather. Shoes are required while both indoors and outdoors.
- Stay on designated trails and specifically avoid areas where vegetation could be impacted. Walk in the middle of the trail, even when wet or muddy. Avoid walking on vegetation as it widens the trail and contributes to erosion.
- Please supervise your children and children within your care at all times. Guests under the age of 16 must be accompanied at all times by an adult.
- Parents, Guardians and Students: Please be aware of your surroundings and other visitors at the center for your safety and theirs.
- Parents and Guardians are expected to provide general guidance and direction concerning mature behavior for the duration of the group's time on the premises.
- Please note that we require a minimum Adult to Student ratio of 1:6 at all times indoors and outdoors, not including Audubon staff or volunteers.
- Please be aware that the center has visitors onsite and will share common areas.
- We recommend reserving a classroom if you would like to host your own program. This includes public indoor and outdoor areas as well. Please email <a href="mailto:trac@audubon.org">trac@audubon.org</a> for pricing and to schedule.
- Parents, Guardians and Students are expected to be respectful of the premises, nature, staff, and volunteers. Do not litter. Please recycle. Please treat all living creatures and objects with respect. Please do not climb on windows or doors.
- Parents / Guardians must be available for emergencies concerning students.
- Parents / Guardians should act as an escort for Students when required. Students should not leave a supervised area without a Parent / Guardian.

## RELEASE OF LIABILITY & USE OF IMAGE BY AN ADULT PARTICIPANT
